Through a joint program between UMCOR and Central Conference episcopal areas, the Disaster Management offices serve as a results-based model to facilitate the UMCOR mandate of training and equipping the church in disaster response by enabling effective, efficient and ethical local disaster response.

Working with the Global Health unit, UMC health boards and local communities develop strategic plans and propose integrated solutions to address issues of community health and wellness. Currently, United Methodist health boards coordinate work in Angola, Burundi, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Tanzania, Liberia, Nigeria, Mozambique, Peru, Philippines, Sierra Leone, Zambia and Zimbabwe.
