- ☐ Are you sensing a call to serve? We invite you to use this **guide** as you reflect on your own and seek advice.
- ☐ Discover the significance of the **core values** of the program.

Verify

- ☐ Are you qualified to apply for the program?
 - Age: be between the ages of 20–30 in 2024 (the year service begins).
 - **Education**: have a bachelor's degree or equivalent life experience.
 - Language: be able to communicate in English at a conversational/professional proficiency. (English is used during interviews, orientation and at some placement sites.)
 - **Commitment**: be able to commit to 2 years of service living in solidarity with a community in a new context and to live out the core values of the Global Mission Fellows program.

Gather and Apply

Collect the following documents and information for the application.

- □ Government ID: all those applying for the International Track must have a valid, unexpired passport.

 NOTE: you can submit the application without a passport attached, but proof of a valid passport <u>must be</u>

 <u>submitted by February 28, 2024</u> for the application to remain active. Those applying for the US-2 Track must also submit a valid government ID and a list of accepted documents is given in the government ID guide.
- ☐ **Transcripts**: scan or request a copy of your school transcripts; in addition, you can also submit any other diplomas or other professional certifications that may support your professional qualifications. NOTE: you can submit the application without this document attached, but it *must be submitted by February 28, 2024*.
- □ **CV/Resume**: update your CV/Resume; we encourage you to take the time to make it as robust and professional as possible (guide and template are available upon request).
- □ **References**: you will need three references for your application, so collect their names and preferred email addresses. You will need one pastoral, one professional, and one academic reference.
- Church Information: details of your church affiliation must be included in the application. Please include:
 - The church address, phone number, and website where you are a member or regular attender.
 - **Methodist applicants**: gather your Annual or Central Conference information, as well as the name and email address of your conference bishop (request this information from your pastor).
 - Non-Methodist applicants: gather the name and email address of your denomination leader.
- **Essays**: these written responses help our staff get to know you on a deeper level; we strongly recommend you reflect on the questions before adding your responses in the application form.
